3. Rushing Water in Kansas City

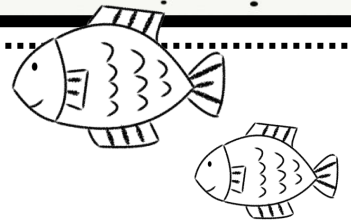
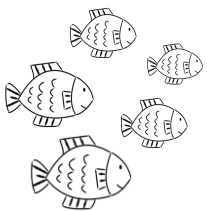
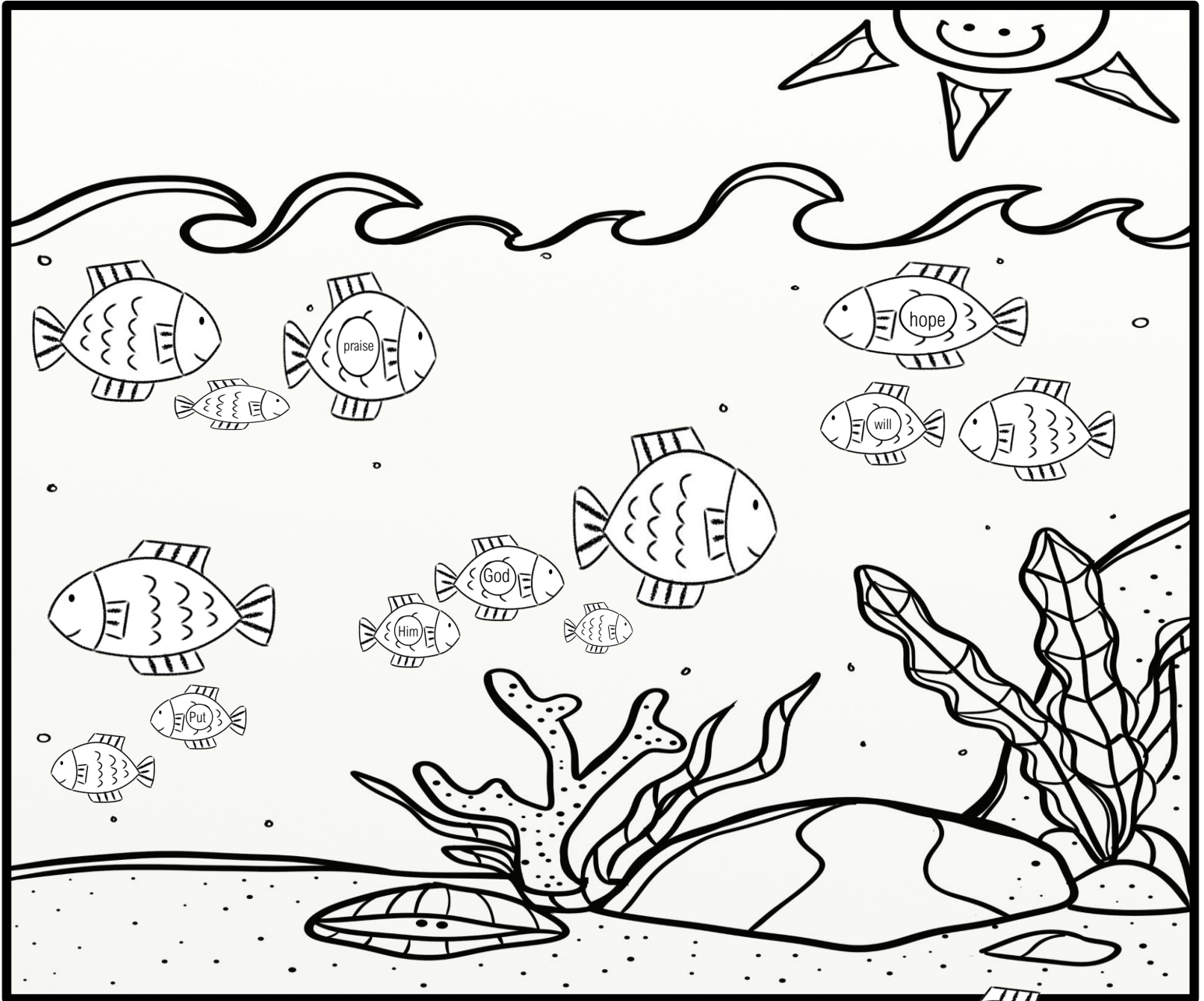
